

Nordic Circle of Artistic Management Mentorship programme

Open Call for Managers, Producers and Self-Producing Choreographers

Do you work with the production of dance in the Nordic or Baltic countries?
Would you like to have the opportunity to work with a mentor for a year to help you grow and develop as a producer?

What

The Nordic Circle of Artistic Management is a continuation of the Mentoring scheme that ran within kedja 2012-2015, in combination with the Nordic/Baltic Producers Network. The project will run open workshops and two cycles of mentorship programmes during the next three years, 2016-2019.

Why

The programme aims to develop the production and management skills across the field of dance. The mentoring sessions will emphasize the empowerment of the individual, strengthening the competences needed to initiate local, Nordic, Baltic, international and cross border activities.

When

The year of mentorship will begin in Stockholm, where all partners will gather for a two-day workshop on the 3-4th of October 2016. All applicants need to be available these dates.

During their year of mentorship, the mentees will communicate individually, and meet with their mentors from whom they can receive coaching on general issues concerning their professional development / the development of their company as well as on concrete cases they are dealing with.

The year will finish in September with all the partners meeting again, to share experiences and lessons learnt. Travel and accommodation costs for mentors and mentees will be provided.

Who

The mentors will be professionals with knowledge and experience within arts management in the independent and institutional performing arts field.

The mentees are expected to have some management education and/or some years of experience in professional management work within dance/the performing arts.
